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Guidelines and Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for an AMHA scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Resident applicant and family must reside in or receive direct housing benefits for the entire senior year (or at least 12 months prior to the application deadline) through any housing program administered by AMHA
2. Must file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by that institution's **FAFSA priority deadline** (**NOTE:** Students are responsible for checking with their institution for the priority filing deadline date)
3. Must be accepted to an accredited postsecondary institution and be enrolled as a full-time student in the Fall of 2010
4. Enroll in the Lima Area Chamber of Commerce **College Access** program

Scholarship Requirements:



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- The applicant must have maintained an overall 2.8 grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale for the total of their high school career. Head of households and previous winners that are in college must have an overall 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- The high school applicant must commit themselves to enrolling in a College/university or vocational training program beyond high school graduation.
- Must submit a copy of the student's high school transcript showing their cumulative grade point average and credits earned (must submit all available and most recent high school transcripts--including current grades)
- Must submit ACT test scores
- Must submit two letters of recommendation from community leaders (not school counselors) such as clergy, employers, teachers, coaches, etc
- Must submit an essay explaining why the applicant wishes to pursue a college degree or vocational training (300-500 words)
- Continuing Requirements:
 - Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5
 - Must be a full-time student (12 hours minimum)
